Nicholas Scheer was born in April 1981. He developed a love for farming early in life and was an invaluable help to his parents with the many responsibilities on their own farm. In addition, he also helped care for his sister, Cindy, who has cerebral palsy. At Kingman High School, he participated on the football team and in FFA, serving as vice president his senior year. Upon graduation, Nicholas attended Hutchinson Community College to study agriculture and animal science. At the time of his tragic death in December 2004, he was half owner in Scheer Custom Swathing and Baling, a business he started with his father. Nicholas was pleasant to everyone he met and was well loved by family, friends and acquaintances.
