

WBG ENDOWED SCHOLARSHIP
U.S.D. #332 Cunningham High School

GUIDELINES:

The WBG Endowed Scholarship will be awarded to a graduating Senior from Cunningham High School meeting the following requirements:

1. The student must graduate with a 2.0 grade point average or better.
2. The student must show average or lower financial need.
3. The student should be well-rounded. She/he should be involved in one or more school or community activities.

SELECTION:

Selection of the WBG Endowed Scholarship recipient will be as follows:

1. The applications will be received in the High School Office by **APRIL 1st**.
2. A committee appointed by the High School Superintendent, Principal or Guidance Counselor will recommend the recipient to South Central Community Foundation. (Amended 4/07: Scholarship committee at school will send #1,2,and 3 ranked applications to Denise, she will rank them and send to Beulah Graber to be ranked).

DISTRIBUTION:

1. The distribution of scholarship funds will be made in two equal payments of \$500 per semester to the college/university of the student's choice upon proof of enrollment.

CONTINGENCIES:

1. In the event that Cunningham High School ceases to exist within U.S.D.# 332 disbursements will be made to students from Kingman County in the successor school district.
2. If there are no eligible candidates, the disbursement will revert to principal in the WBG Endowed Fund.
